Motorola is a company that has been producing smartphones since 1996. The first Motorola was successful enough to make it onto the New York Stock Exchange before any other brand of mobile phone. Motorola has made many different kinds of wireless devices such as two-way radios, pagers, cordless phones and network equipment. The company has changed ownership a number of times since the mid-90s and is currently owned by Lenovo. The Motorola brand was known for its line of Android smartphones. In the past, Motorola's Android smartphones were very popular because they were some of the first affordable Android phones with a decent build quality from a major manufacturer. In the years since its acquisition by Lenovo, Motorola has been struggling to maintain its position in the smartphone market. In 2015, Google announced that it would be selling Motorola Mobility to Lenovo for US\$2.9 billion (US\$350 million in cash and US\$2.78 billion in Lenovo shares). The deal included a set of patents that Motorola Mobility had used to create smartphones and tablets. Most smartphones today use either the Android OS or the Linux-based Chrome OS operating system, but many of Motorola's smartphones were based on a variant of Android called "Motoblur". Without the large number of notable Motorola devices at their disposal, Lenovo CEO Yang Yuanqing said that Motorola would have to "strengthen the brand from within" and redouble its efforts to make innovative products. In February 2017, Lenovo announced plans to sell off Moto's hardware division by the end of April 2017. In March 2017, reports surfaced that Google was in talks to buy Moto for around \$2 billion. On July 25, 2017, Google announced that it had agreed to acquire Lenovo's Motorola Mobility unit for US\$2.91 billion (subject to certain adjustments), including US\$1.41 billion paid at close, comprised of US\$660 million in cash and US\$750 million in Google (GOOG) stock. The deal is expected to close by early 2018. Subsequently, on August 7, 2017, it was announced that the acquisition had been completed a week earlier on August 1. The Moto G is a line of mid-range Android smartphones from Motorola Mobility that run the Android operating system, version 4.4.4 "KitKat" with a build number of KK. In 2014, Motorola updated the G with the "G" model, which included a dual frontal-facing LED flash and Ultrapixel camera sensor improvements. The latest iteration is the Moto G5 Plus which also has an upgraded camera sensor and a fingerprint scanner on its rear-facing device... The Moto X was a line of smartphones from Motorola Mobility that ran Android OS, version 4.1 with a Build Number of KOT49H.
